Speaking at council is fun and easy. Signing up to speak at council on the other hand can be a bit of a challenge. Never fear, we've prepared a guide to navigating the sign-up process, to ensure that everyone who wants to speak can have their chance to be heard.

The first section is pretty straightforward: confirm that you have read and agree with the privacy and conduct statements. Add in your name, pronunciation if necessary, pronouns and e-mail address. From there on, use the screenshots below as a guide to the rest of the form. Note that while the form does ask you to choose whether you'll be speaking in-person or remotely, it's not set in stone and if your circumstances change you're free to change how you present.
